The RocksExpo experience includes—

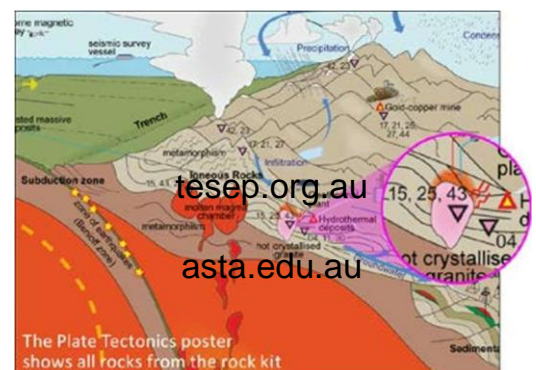
1. **Incursions** – classroom lessons with students and teachers.

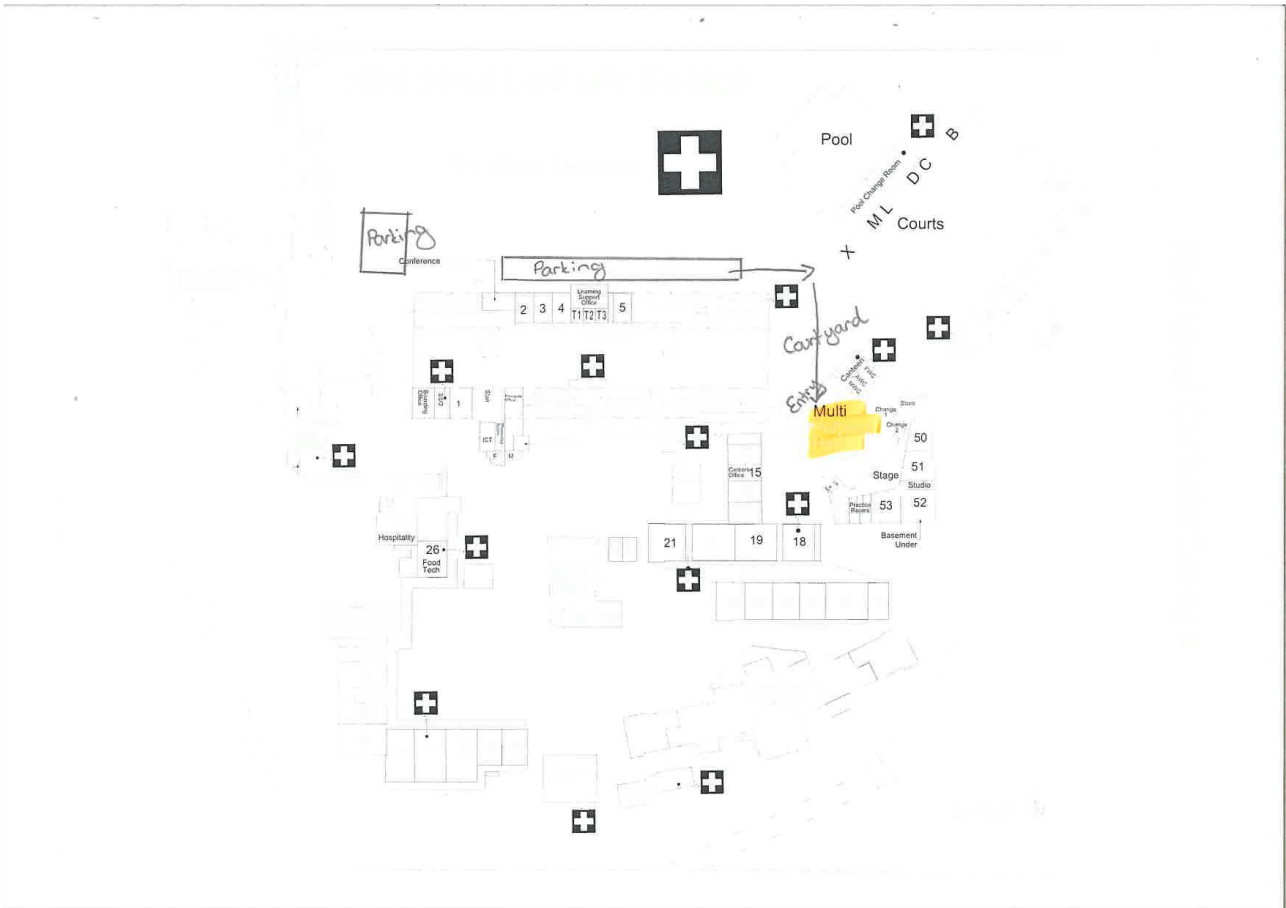
